WITHDRAWAL

- 1. Parents seeking transfer certificate must give an application for the same in the school office before **5th March** of that academic year.
- 2. School Leaving Certificate / Transfer Certificate will be issued to those who have cleared all their dues. Fees has to be paid for the entire month of the date of TC Application.

LEAVE

- 1. A student who has been present in the morning SHALL NOT GO HOME in the course of school hours except with the permission of the Principal. Half day leave is not entertained.
- 2. No student shall remain absent without leave sanctioned in advance by the Principal except in unforeseen circumstances.
- 3. In case, leave is applied for any type of sickness for more than 3 days, a medical certificate must be submitted on resuming.
- 4. Student suffering from contagious disease should not attend the school and should apply for leave. Medical fitness certificate should be produced at the time of resuming classes.
- 5. Repeated absence for feasts, weddings etc. render the student liable to dismissal.
- 6. All are expected to attend school on the re-opening day after every vacation. Absence without written permission (mere informing will not suffice) renders the pupils liable to being struck off from the roll.
- 7. Absence from the school on the last day of the term and on the first day of the new term may lead to the student's name being struck off from the roll.
- 8. Attendance is compulsory for all the School celebrations.
- 9. It is compulsory for students to complete 75% attendance in the academic year, to make them eligible for promotion to the next class.
- 10. New academic year begins from April, attendance is compulsory on the first day.

LIBRARY RULES

The school has **one well equipped library.** All classes are provided with nearly 15000 books with at least one library period per week. The students can avail E-Library facility of more than 5000 books.

- 1. Students are allowed to borrow books of their choice to read at home.
- 2. Students are not allowed to carry their personal books, CD, bag or any other belongings to the library.
- 3. Books marked, disfigured, damaged or lost, will have to be replaced or paid by the borrower.

1. COMPUTER LAB

The school has a well equipped air conditioned computer lab with one computer per student. All the IT related programmes and classes are conducted for the students of Nursery to Std. VIII. Each student is given an individual computer during the class.

2. 3D ROOM

The audio visual room Seminar Hall is well equipped with all the required facilities for holding seminars, workshops, presentations as well as regular lectures.

Science & Maths is also taught in 3D Room.

3. MATHS LAB

The school will have a well equipped, comprehensive colourful Maths laboratory where regular maths teaching and activities are conducted for all the students from Std. I onwards as per the time table given.

4. PLAY ROOM (INDOOR)

The school has an exemplar Play Room with colourful rubber flooring and indoor play equipment for Pre Primary students.

5. PLAY AREA (OUTDOOR)

School will have a large Play Area with colourful SBR rubber shred, to form a highly shock absorbing cushion and a base layer for safety. It also has numerous play equipment for the Primary students.

6. YOGA HALL

The School will have big airy hall with all the necessary equipment for Yoga and Meditation. All students of Std I to VIII perform Yoga and Meditation in this hall.

7. SCIENCE LAB

To facilitate the learning of Science the school has 4 well resourced and modernised Science Labs.

The School has well engineered Composite Lab for Std I to Std. VIII.

The School has well established, specialised Physics, Chemistry and Biology Labs for Std IX to Std XII is also ready.

8. INDOOR GAMES ROOM

To provide the updated indoor facility to the students, the school has a spacious Sport's Hall especially designed with best Indoor sporting facilities to play many indoor games like Table Tennis, Carrom, Chess etc for Std I to Std VIII.

9. KARATE

A great team of talented black belt instructors along with extensive training space provides best Taekwondo experience to students of Std I to Std VIII in the second floor open area.

We also have a great collection of martial arts training equipment like kick pads, focus mits and traditional weight aids on hand for each class.

10. CO-CURRICULAR ACTIVITIES

With the view to develop the potential talents of the students and building up character and personality, the following co-curricular activities are offered:

11. STUDENT COUNCIL

The school will have an effective and functional Student's Council. The students are selected from higher classes after scrutiny of their academic records, attitude and aptitude. The Student Council consists of Head Boy, Head Girl, Assistant Head Boy and Assistant Head Girl, Sports Captain, Sports Vice-Captain, House Captains and House Vice Captains and House Prefects.

The Students Council along with class monitors have the following tasks to perform:

- 1. To help in maintaining the discipline of the school.
- 2. To co-ordinate and offer help in all the school functions.
- 3. To exhibit leadership qualities.

- 4. To set an example of disciplined individuals, respectful towards all teachers and elders. Also to abide by the school rules.
- 5. To give meaningful feedback and information to the Principal towards changes if required in various school routines.
- 6. To perform all tasks cheerfully, willingly and maintaining their own high academic performances.

LATE ARRIVAL

- 1. The school reporting time for Pre-Primary students in the Morning Session is 8:30 a.m. and for Afternoon Session is 11:30 a.m.
- 2. The school reporting time for Std. I to Std. VIII in the Morning Session is 8:30 a.m.
- 3. The student will be sent back home on late arrival once the gate closes.

GENERAL RULES

- 1. Every student must carry the school calendar and identity card to school every day.
- 2. Students who come to School by private conveyance or escorts, should never leave the school premises before the private conveyance or escort arrives. In case of delay, they should report to the school office.
- 3. The school does not permit the celebration of birthdays in the school campus. Parents are allowed to send only pen, pencil, rubber etc. for the class.
- 4. Irregular attendance, unjustified or unexplained absence for more than three working days, habitual idleness, disobedience or objectionable moral influence, justify dismissal.
- 5. Any type of discourtesy or disrespect to the members of the school staff will be considered as a breach of discipline.
- 6. Any kind of damage done in the school premises will have to be paid by the parent of the pupil concerned.
- 7. Great stress is laid on personal hygiene and cleanliness. The uniform must be clean and neatly ironed, finger nails pared and hair cut short. Shabby, unkempt and fancy hair styles will not be permitted inside the school campus.
- 8. Wearing necklace, earrings and bracelets are strictly disallowed.
- 9. Colouring of hair or putting mehendi or nailpolish is not allowed.

- 10. Running, playing or shouting inside the school premises is not allowed.
- 11. All students must wear the prescribed uniform, shoes and socks whenever students are called on holidays or after school for extra class or games.
- 12. Every Wednesday, the pupils are expected to wear P. T. uniform and Track Suit for special activities.
- 13. All students are expected to speak only in English. Action will be taken against the student who speaks in any other language.
- 14. The students are expected to co-operate with Student Council to maintain the discipline and ideals of the school. During the absence of teachers, the monitors, prefects will be responsible for the discipline of the class.
- 15. Parents must give lunch box to their wards as no student is allowed to leave the school premises during regular school hours. However canteen facility is available. Lunch box should not be sent during the school hours.
- 16. The students are expected to come prepared to school with all that is necessary, for the day's work. Borrowing or lending of pencils, pens, rulers etc. is discouraged.
- 17. When the students move in the corridors, while changing class they must walk in silence and in a single line. They should always keep to the left. The teacher should be the last to leave the class.
- 18. Every student must have a proper school bag. No book should be carried loose in a plastic bag.
- 19. Running up or down the stairs is to be avoided strictly.
- 20. During lunch break, students should not run in the corridor or class as they may get injured or injure other students.
- 21. Students should not bring valuable articles like watches, mobile phones, Ipods, laptops or any other electronic equipment to school.
- 22. Students should avoid using plastic bags and use of thermocol while making projects. Bringing sharp object / tools is strictly prohibited.
- 23. Students should not pluck leaves and flowers from the garden.

PRINCIPLES OF DISCIPLINE FOR PUPILS AS QUOTED IN S.S CODE SECTION VIII

Principles of Discipline

- **56.1** Head of the school shall see that the principles of discipline are properly observed. Regularity and implicit obedience should be insisted upon. Politeness and courtesy of speech and conduct as well as cleanliness of dress and personal hygiene should be inculcated.
- **56.2** Pupils should realise that they are responsible to the school authorities not only for their conduct in the school but also for their general behaviour outside. Anyone reported or observed of objectionable conduct out of the school, on the part of the pupils should make them liable for disciplinary action.
- 56.3 Parents or guardians are given to understand that they cannot dictate to the management and that the management has a right to say on what conditions they will admit or retain pupils in their school provided such conditions are in conformity with the authority from time to time. Pupils shall not take part in any political activity.
- 56.4 Any pupil who is persistently insubordinate or is repeatedly or wilfully mischievious or is guilty of malpractices in connection with examinations or has committed an act of serious indiscipline and/or misbehaviour, or who, in the opinion of the Head of the school, has a detrimental influence on his fellow-pupils, may be expelled permanently from the school or for a specified period by the Head of the school. The reasons thereof should be recorded in writing. The matter should be reported immediately by the Head to the appropriate authority and in no case later than 7 days of expulsion, with the name of the pupil expelled, together with full details of the reasons for the action taken.

CODE OF CONDUCT

- 1) All students should come to school on time.
- 2) Attendance in assembly is compulsory.
- 3) Be always friendly with your classmates.
- 4) The students should always carry and display their I-Card in the school bus and inside the school premises.
- 5) No student or group of students are allowed to leave the class without the Pink Card (Errand Card). The Errand Card should be used by the student who move out of the class during school hours.
- 6) Movement of students from one classroom to other for PT/ Music Computer Lab/Science Lab/Library/arrival/dispersal should be in a proper queue.
- 7) All students to do whatever work is assigned to them cheerfully.
- 8) Always greet your Principal and Staff Members' courteously.
- 9) Take an honest pride in keeping the premises of your school, clean and tidy; **INFORM THE PRINCIPAL OF ANY DAMAGES.**
- 10) Avoid littering in the school compound, classroom and stairways; pickup any litter you notice and throw them in the dustbin.
- 11) No student is allowed to leave the premises during Recess break. Students should bring their lunch box with them.
- 12) No student will stay back in the class without the permission of the Subject Teacher/Class Teacher.
- 13) Students should use only specified washrooms / water coolers assigned to them. Wastage of time and improper conduct in the wash room is strictly prohibited.
- 14) Take pride in keeping up the high morale of the school.
- 15) Always be obedient and respectful to your parents; be grateful to them for the love and affection they have showered upon you ever since you were born.
- 16) Do not be noisy and quarrelsome; but try to be gentle, cheerful and polite. Endeavour to keep up the **pre-eminence** of the school, by excelling in good manners.

- 17) Remember that study is your first duty as a student; do not neglect your home-work and assignments.
- 18) Be polite to all your elders; assist old, blind and needy persons. Also respect the rights of others.
- 19) All students are expected to take care of the school property and should not damage it. Strict disciplinary action will be taken against students who are found guilty of damaging property or are involved in any theft/stealing or any other unethical practices.
- 20) Use of abusive language and misbehaviour with classmates/ seniors will call for strict disciplinary action.
- 21) A student should not indulge in any kind of unfair means during the examinations. Action will be taken against those who are found guilty.
- 22) Students identified for remedial classes should stay back and compulsorily attend classes.
- 23) No student is allowed to show aggressive behaviour /use of physical violence like pushing, hitting, kicking, stone throwing, boxing, slapping etc. Students are expected to give due respect and regard to all the teachers. Any disrespectful behaviour with teachers may call for disciplinary action.
- 24) Lending or borrowing of money or other articles is not allowed. Students are advised to keep their class room/ school building/ campus as neat as possible and throw leftovers only in the dustbin only.
- 25) Since it is a co-educational school, it is expected that students behave in a manner which brings a good name to the school, community and do not indulge in any immoral or anti-social activity inside or outside the school.
- 26) It is expected from senior students that the juniors should be treated with love and affection.
- 27) Remind yourself of your duties to God; prayer will bring Him nearer to you.

GUIDELINES FOR PARENTS

- 1. Parents should check if their ward carries the school calendar every day.
- 2. Parents must also check the calendar everyday to see if their ward has completed all the home assignments given by the teachers. They should check the remarks column too.
- 3. Parents must take keen interest in all the activities conducted in the school, by encouraging their ward to take part in the activities.
- 4. It is the duty of the parent to see that their ward comes to the class in a neat and clean uniform.
- 5. The students should be dropped at the school gate on time.
- 6. Parents should not enter the classroom or meet teachers without written permission of the Principal. Only 2nd Saturday parents can meet the class teacher or subject teachers between 9:00 am to 10:00 am.
- 7. Any change of address / telephone number should be notified to the class teacher and school office immediately.
- 8. No short leave / half day leave is allowed. Do not make social engagements or medical appointments for your ward during working hours.
- 9. Inform the head of the institution, class teacher in case your ward suffers from any specific disease allergy or has undergone an operation and is under medication.
- 10. Ensure that your child maintains personal hygiene, sleeps for 8 hours daily, has a nutritious diet and avoids consumptions of junk food or eatables from the roadside vendors.
